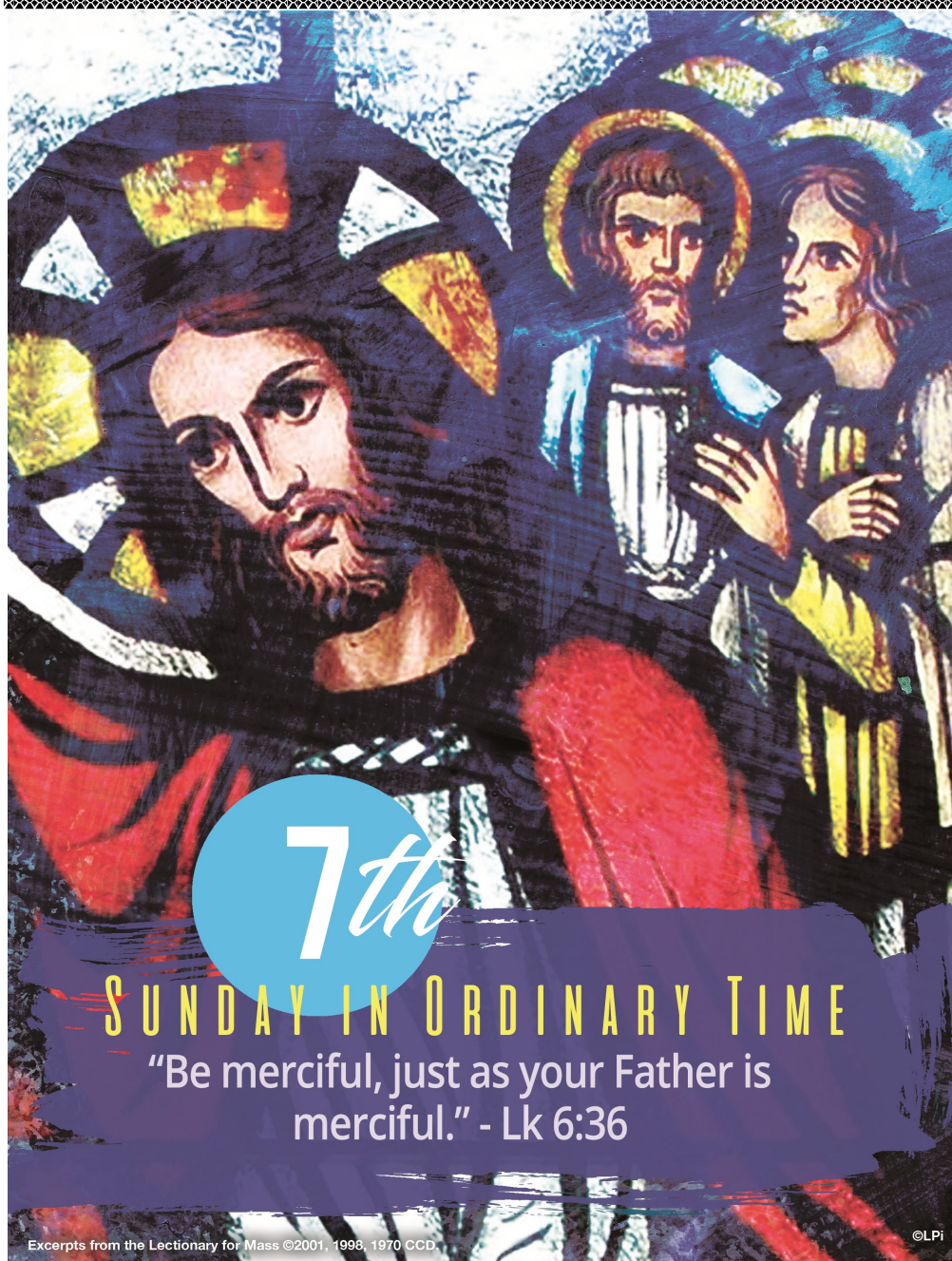

Permanent Deacons are ordained to serve the People of God. They assist at the altar, proclaim the Gospel, preach, and preside at baptisms, weddings, funerals and other liturgies. They teach, counsel, administrate, visit the sick and serve the poor. The Diocese of Las Cruces has begun its recruitment of its next class of Deacons. Between now and the end of May 2019 the Office of Deacon Formation is accepting preliminary applications to the Deacon Program. The Year of Inquiry into the Diaconate will begin in August 2019. Inquirers will meet one evening a month for prayer, presentation and discernment.
