As we gather to worship, social distancing style, here are a few friendly reminders:

**For those who plan to attend mass inside the church...**

Please sit in the designated areas. A face mask must be worn at all times while in the church. At the reception of communion, you will receive the Eucharist in your hand, step to the side, pull your face mask down to take communion and replace your mask. At this time we are limited to having 62 people in the church. A sign will be posted on the church door if we have reached the occupancy limit. Cleaned and sanitized missalette and hymnbooks are located in the foyer of the church. If you use one during mass, please leave it in the pew at the end of mass so that it can be sanitized. The church will need to be sanitized after each mass. Please help us by leaving the kneeler down where you sat so that we will know which areas need to be sanitized. Thank you for your help!
