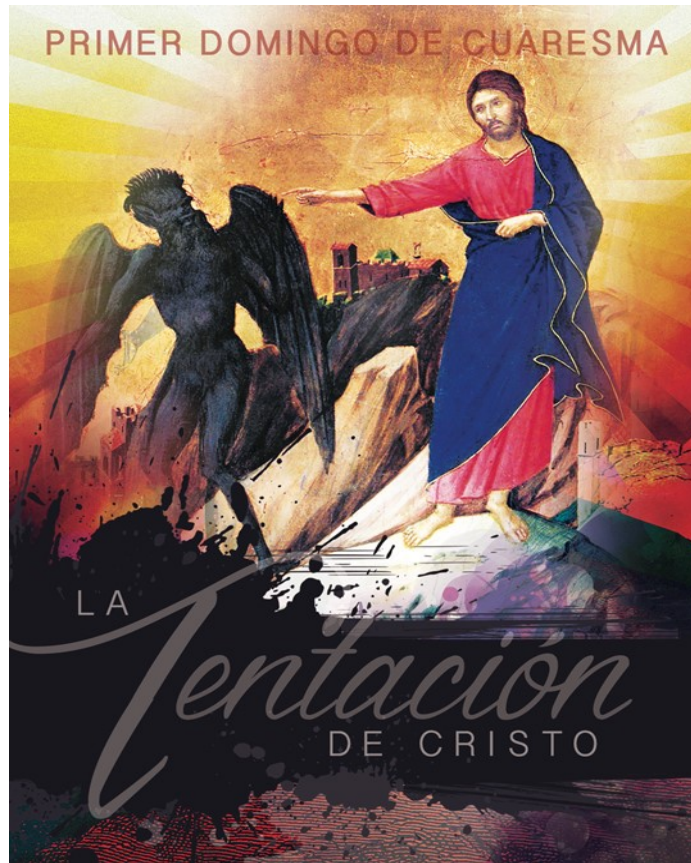
ST. GENEVIEVE'S MISSION STATEMENT

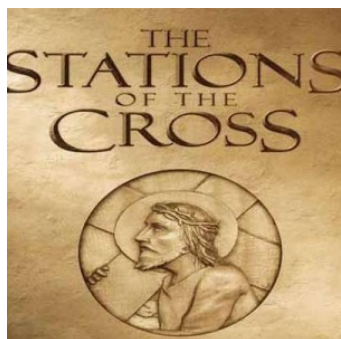

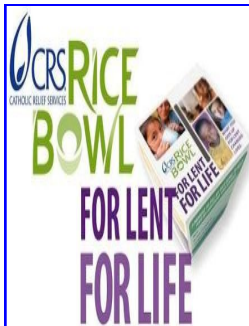

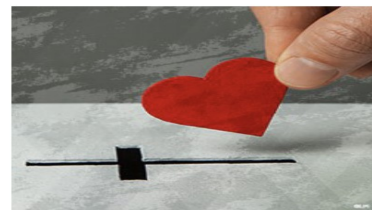

Genuflecting & Kneeling

Question:

Does it matter what leg you kneel on when genuflecting?

Answer:

Genuflection is an act of devotion that literally means "to bend the knee." For many Catholics, it's an almost automatic gesture that we perform before entering our pew or row of seats at Mass. But, like many of the symbols and gestures of our faith tradition, genuflecting can also be an invitation for deeper reflection. The practice of "bending the knee" is an ancient way of recognizing the presence of someone greater than we are. It has been said that the practice dates back to the time of Alexander the Great, but it became a common part of etiquette in the royal courts of the Middle Ages. From throne rooms and palaces, it was a small step to genuflecting, becoming part of the devotional lives of Christians who used this secular gesture as a way of recognizing the presence of the One who is King of Kings, especially in the Eucharist. In our tradition, although many have been taught or prefer to genuflect by placing their right knee on the ground, there is no prescribed way to genuflect. This is especially important to keep in mind if physical limitations or age make certain movements difficult for us.

Today, Catholics are asked to genuflect in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (whether in the tabernacle or exposed on the altar during eucharistic adoration). So, while it has become second nature to genuflect before entering your seat in church, we should pay attention to where the Blessed Sacrament is kept in each church or chapel we visit, and genuflect in the direction of the tabernacle where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. In churches or chapels in which the tabernacle is in a separate space, we are invited to simply bow toward the altar.

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Arrodillarse Y Arrodiarse

Pregunta: ¿Importa en qué pierna te arrodilles al hacer la genuflexión?

Respuesta: La genuflexión es un acto de devoción que literalmente significa "doblar la rodilla." Para muchos católicos, es un gesto casi automático que realizamos antes de entrar en nuestro banco o fila de asientos en la Misa. Pero, como muchos de los símbolos y gestos de nuestra tradición de fe, la genuflexión también puede ser una invitación a una reflexión más profunda. La práctica de "doblar la rodilla" es una forma antigua de reconocer la presencia de alguien más grande que nosotros. Se ha dicho que la práctica se remonta a la época de Alejandro Magno, pero se convirtió en una parte común de la etiqueta en las cortes reales de la Edad Media. Desde las salas del trono y los Palacios, fue un pequeño paso hacia la genuflexión, pasando a formar parte de la vida devocional de Los Cristianos que utilizaron este gesto secular como una forma de reconocer la presencia de aquel que es rey de Reyes, especialmente en la Eucaristía. En nuestra tradición, aunque muchos han sido enseñados o prefieren hacer la genuflexión colocando su rodilla derecha en el suelo, no hay una forma prescrita de hacer la genuflexión. Esto es especialmente importante a tener en cuenta si las limitaciones físicas o la edad nos dificultan ciertos movimientos.

Hoy en día, se pide a los católicos que se arrodillen en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento (ya sea en el tabernáculo o expuesto en el altar durante la adoración eucarística). Por lo tanto, mientras que se ha convertido en una segunda naturaleza hacer una genuflexión antes de entrar en su asiento en la Iglesia, debemos prestar atención a dónde se guarda el Santísimo Sacramento en cada iglesia o capilla que visitamos, y hacer una genuflexión en la dirección del tabernáculo donde se guarda el Santísimo Sacramento. En las iglesias o capillas en las que el tabernáculo está en un espacio separado, se nos invita a inclinarnos simplemente hacia el altar.

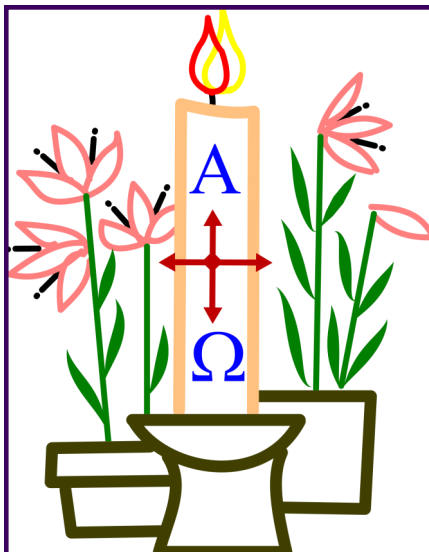
