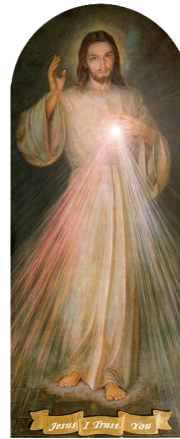

Question: What is spiritual communion, and do you need to be in a state of grace to receive it?

Answer: The practice of making a "spiritual communion" dates back several centuries and St. Thomas Aquinas described it as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him." Traditionally, a prayer of spiritual communion has been used by those who are unable to receive sacramental communion because of health, inability to attend Mass, or who cannot receive communion because of grave sin. This practice has been encouraged by many saints and spiritual writers and most recently Pope Francis encouraged the practice when the realities of the COVID-19 pandemic prevented so many Catholics from taking part in the Mass or receiving sacramental communion.

Although the graces offered in spiritual communion are not the same as those offered in the sacramental communion of the Mass, this practice is still a powerful opportunity to express our desire for union with the Lord and to be united with Christ and the Church, even in an imperfect way.

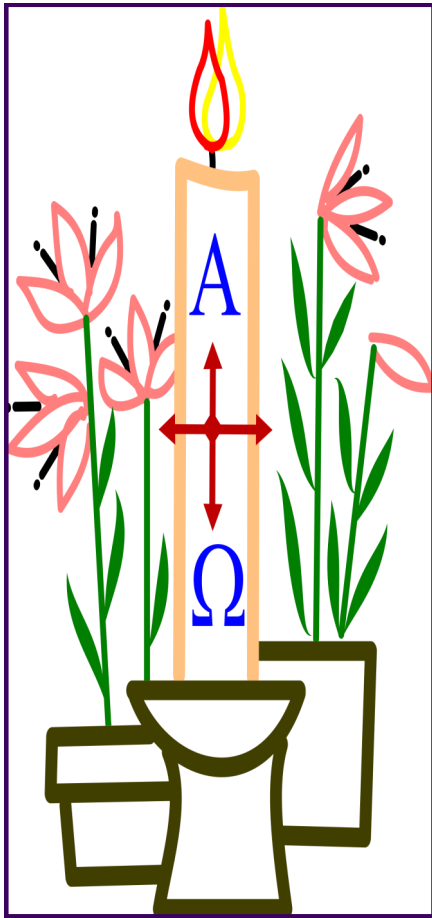
Comunión Espiritual

Pregunta: ¿Qué es la comunión espiritual y necesitas estar en estado de gracia para recibirla?

Respuesta: La práctica de hacer una "comunión espiritual" se remonta a varios siglos atrás y Santo Tomás de Aquino la describió como "un ardiente deseo de recibir a Jesús en el Santo Sacramento y un abrazo amoroso como si ya lo hubiéramos recibido". Tradicionalmente, una oración de comunión espiritual ha sido utilizada por aquellos que no pueden recibir la comunión sacramental debido a la salud, la incapacidad de asistir a la misa o que no pueden recibir la comunión debido al pecado grave. Esta práctica ha sido alentada por muchos santos y escritores espirituales y más recientemente el Papa Francisco alentó la práctica cuando las realidades de la pandemia COVID-19 impidieron que tantos católicos participaran en la misa o recibieran la comunión sacramental.

Aunque las gracias ofrecidas en la comunión espiritual no son las mismas que las ofrecidas en la comunión sacramental de la misa, esta práctica sigue siendo una poderosa oportunidad para expresar nuestro deseo de unión con el Señor y de estar unidos con Cristo y la Iglesia, incluso de manera imperfecta.
